#### Title:

Children's Ministry (CM) Director

## Scope:

Coordination of children's ministry, ages 3 through 6<sup>th</sup> grade – for entire Sunday program, (approximately 150-200 children)

## **Spiritual Gifts:**

Leadership, Shepherding, Teaching, Administration, Encouragement

#### **Responsibilities:**

The CM Director is responsible to assist the pastors by developing a healthy, high quality children's program that will:

- a. Attract new families to our church;
- b. Lay a strong spiritual foundation for our children;
- c. Care for and shepherd lay workers in the CM.

Specific responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

#### Ministry Direction and Leadership

- Provide vision and set direction for CM in line with the overall CCUC visions
- Set age-appropriate goals, Bible curriculum and learning objectives for all areas of CM ministries for children ages 3 through 6<sup>th</sup> grade and set up processes to assess students spiritual formation
- Establish and implement safety and security policies for children at church and on field trips
- Coordinate CM activities according to church calendar and in support of church activities
- Monitor and evaluate CM programs and volunteer staff
- Assist pastors in strategic outreach of children and their families with follow-up
- Plan and direct creative CM programming to meet curriculum objectives
- Provide a clear channel of communication with parents/caregivers of CCUC children
- Oversee CM budget and the coordination of facilities for CM

# Shepherding and Leadership Development

- Set up guidelines for training and criteria for selection of teachers/worship leaders/CM support personnel
- Establish and develop CM volunteer staffing model with job descriptions for each position
- Identify, recruit and train volunteers to serve in their "gift based" ministries
- Develop and implement procedures for tracking volunteers and children
- Build CM community where staff and volunteers can sharpen and encourage one another
- Shepherd(i.e. support, nurture, and lead) a team of CM coordinators who in turn shepherd others so all CM lay leaders are personally cared for within an appropriate span of care

# Expectations

As a member of the CCUC Pastoral Staff, this individual is expected to:

- 1. Model and teach the mission and values of CCUC Children's Ministry
- 2. Maintain a close spiritual walk with God and a godly lifestyle
- 3. Participate as a team player on the staff
- 4. Minister with a commitment to excellence for the glory of God
- 5. Foster a positive family life (as applicable)

# Accountability

The Children's Ministry Director is accountable to the English pastoral staff members (to be determined).

- 1. Monthly reports are to be submitted to the English pastoral staff member (to be determined) on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month.
- 2. Attend weekly staff meetings

# Qualifications

- 1. A clear testimony of personal salvation and evidence of a strong commitment to Jesus Christ.
- 2. Have one of the followings:
  - a. Bachelor degree with five or more years of children ministry experience (6th grade and under).
  - b. Bachelor degree from a Christian college with two or more years of children ministry experience.
  - c. Master degree of Christian Education with one or more years of children ministry experience.
- 3. Ability to work as a team player and submit to authority.
- 4. Ability to teach and communicate creatively and effectively.
- 5. Ability to motivate and train others.
- 6. Ability to organize and plan.
- 7. Calling to ministry to children and the ability to interact dynamically with them.
- 8. Fluent in English ( Mandarin or Cantonese desired )
