NORTHERN SEMINARY: DMin – Master of Divinity Equivalency

Admission to a Doctor of Ministry program requires a Master of Divinity degree, or its educational equivalent from an accredited institution with at least a 3.0 (B) average.

Northern Seminary uses the following template to determine whether an applicant who has not earned an accredited MDiv degree meets the minimum number of masters- level courses and hours to qualify for MDiv equivalency.

- An equivalency assessment will be considered for those students who have earned a two-year, theologically-oriented degree equivalent to a minimum of 52 semester hours or 78 quarter hours from an accredited institution.
- After the Seminary completes its assessment, if it is determined that the student is more than 12 semester hours or 18 quarter hours deficient, those hours must be completed prior to beginning doctoral studies. Once the student is deficient only 12 semester hours or 18 quarter hours, they may register for doctoral course work.
- After being admitted, students who need to complete courses toward MDiv equivalency will be required to enroll in classes for graded credit from an accredited institution to complete the balance of course work.
- Grades for courses taken toward equivalency must be recorded before the student is permitted to register for the final Doctor of Ministry course, Thesis Design.
- Many, if not all, masters-level courses that students may need to take for equivalency will be
 available through Northern's on-campus, weekend, intensive, and online course options. However,
 students may take courses at any accredited institution.
